Wagner is a guy who runs a make shift youth center in one of the slums of Fortaleza. He takes about 80 kids off the streets and onto the beach and teaches them to surf. I told him that was all well and good, but the only true intervention from the lure of drugs and the street, is Jesus Christ. He invited me to the slum to check out the youth center and asked if we could start a bible study there as well. Wagner was so impressed by our willingness to assist him and of our testimonies of Jesus' love that he accepted Christ as his Savior two days later. WOW! Bible study number three! ~ God is Amazing! From a family vacation to a mission trip that has begun 3 bible studies. Only the Holy Spirit can do those kind of miracles. The people of Fortaleza are hungry for The Truth. They want to know who Jesus really is and they want Him ...NOW!
